

- 5. **Row 5:** Ch 3, dc in the next dc, \*sc in the next 3 sc, dc in the next dc; rep from \* to the end of the row, turn.

- 6. Row 6: Repeat Row 2.
- 7. Row 7: Ch 3, dc in the next dc, \*sc in the next 4 sc, dc in the next dc; rep from \* to the end of the row, turn.
- 8. **Row 8:** Ch 3, dc in the next dc, \*sc in the next 5 sc, dc in the next dc; rep from \* to the end of the row, turn.
- 9. **Row 9:** Ch 3, dc in the next dc, \*sc in the next 6 sc, dc in the next dc; rep from \* to the end of the row, turn.
- 10. Row 10: Repeat Row 2.

Once you have completed the desired number of rows, you can finish off the lace by working a row of single crochets around the edge.


