Montongo. Over the past decade, Montongo Roads has implemented a wide range of programs, including:

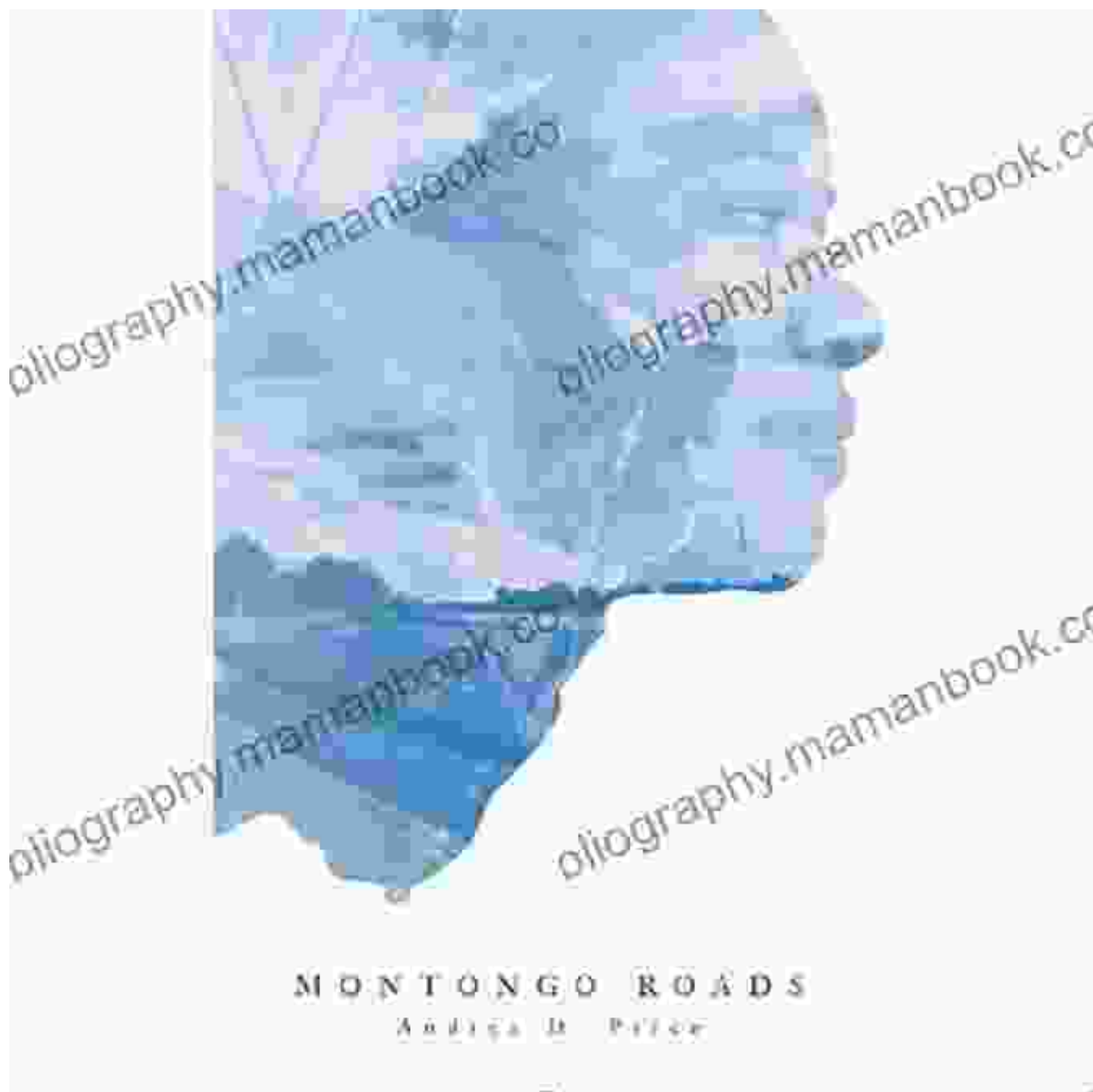
- Building a clean water system that provides safe drinking water to the entire village

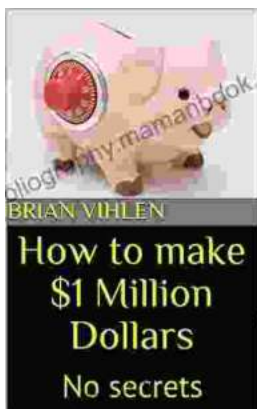
